

Eurotransplant is an international organ-exchange organization that covers Austria, Belgium, Croatia, Germany, Hungary, Luxemburg, the Netherlands, and Slovenia. Partners in the organ-exchange process include transplant hospitals, tissue-typing laboratories, hospitals where organ donations take place and national competent authorities. The Eurotransplant region includes a population of approx. 135 million people.

The responsibility of the Medical Director is directed to further improvement of organ allocation rules, support of the different Eurotransplant advisory committees, coordination of the implementation of adapted allocations processes, development and management of data registries. Candidates should be experienced conducting or coordinating transplant-related research and presenting scientific data at international conferences and meetings. The Medical Director will have to represent Eurotransplant to its stakeholders regarding all aspects of his portfolio.

Applicants should have a medical degree and substantial experience in the field of organ transplantation. Ideally, the candidates should be fluent in English and German, and be prepared to learn Dutch, if not already a Dutch speaker.

Eurotransplant tries to maintain an equal gender ratio. The terms of employment comply with the Dutch collective labor agreement for hospitals and include several fringe benefits.
